e would like to thank all within the pro-life community who made a stand for the preborn during the latest 40 Days for Life campaign. Your commitment to prayer, fasting, and sidewalk counseling has continued to bear fruit. Twenty-five clients were referred to our Hempstead Center through the 40 Days for Life campaign and one of those consultations resulted in a baby save!

The following services – see breakdown by number below – were provided:

Birth control education – 3; Baby needs – 12; OB-GYN referrals – 2; Consultations – 2; Pregnancy test kits – 6. Of these six, three were negative and three were positive. One client to parent, one still undecided and one abortionminded client resulted in a baby save! Please pray for the client who is still undecided about keeping her pregnancy.

Thanks also to sidewalk advocates who handed out our "Women First Pregnancy Options" pamphlets to people entering Planned Parenthood and people in the community. Last, but not least, thank you to the PBFL (Pro Bikers for Life) and PBFL Chaplain Father Liam, as well as to the many prayer warriors that attended various 40 Days for Life campaigns throughout Long Island.

Thoughts and prayers for Father Fidelis CFR, NYC, and the other Red Rose rescuers imprisoned for peacefully defending the dignity of the preborn in Michigan.

We humbly ask that you continue to pray in front of your local Planned Parenthood. Your presence is a much needed and powerful prolife witness to the community. Please consider participating in the upcoming Rosary Rally mentioned on page 4. Only you can be a voice for the voiceless!

Alexing Loving Memory of Damian Geminder



/ith sorrowful hearts, we announce that Damian Jon Geminder, our former Communication Coordinator for the Life Center, entered into Life Eternal on April 20, 2023. By Damian's side were his Father, Fr. Jon Geminder, and his Mother, Donna, of St. Mary's Episcopal Church in Amityville. With no known family history of cardiac issues, Damian was a healthy 33 year old who suffered a massive heart attack. He fought for seven weeks and two days, going from Good Samaritan Hospital, to St. Francis, then to Columbian Presbyterian.

His prolife journey started when he was raised in a home first owned by a suffragist. Then, as a teenager, his sister Jessica introduced him to Feminists for Life whereupon receiving his master's in journalism, he became their part-time editor.. ironically on Susan B.

Anthony's birthday. Damian devoted his life to serving those at greatest

risk—women and the preborn—hence joining the Life Center as our part-time Communication Coordinator. Damian's editorials met women where their minds were at. He sparked their hope while informing of the many resources available that would make the lives of women and their children better, as to make abortion unthinkable.

May the choirs of Angels bring Damian to his heavenly home to be greeted by our Lord and Mother Mary to whom Damian was strongly devoted. May Damian's soul and the souls of all the Faithful
