Deacon Frank Gariboldi


Deacon Frank was ordained in DRVC on May 18, 1996. He was the DRVC's Project Rachel Coordinator while Msgr. Jim Lisante was the Respect Life Coordinator for the Diocese. There Frank learned how important it is for women and men who have experienced abortion to be reconciled with God and to encounter his love, mercy, and forgiveness. So, when he learned about the Rachel's Vineyard Retreat Program, he and Lorraine, the Executive Director, brought the program to the Life Center on Long Island. Since then, Frank has coordinated and attended 25 weekend retreats, with over five hundred participants, and over 1,000 aborted babies being memorialized during Retreat Masses.
Frank also established the Life Center Baby Bottle Campaigns here on Long Island which have been going strong for over 17 years. The funds raised through these campaigns have been vital in helping us expand our reach throughout Long Island to save babies from abortion.

Frank and Lorraine have been married for 31 years. Together they have seven adult children, twenty-six grandchildren and thirty-three great grandchildren. They now reside in Apollo Beach, FL, where they hope to implement the Rachel Vineyard Retreat program. Frank was a Board Member of the Life Center of L.I. and worked at the Hospice Inn, Melville, NY. One of Frank's greatest accomplishments was graduating from St. John's University with a degree in Theology at the age of 75.

YAI residents volunteer their time on most Tuesdays and Thursdays to help out at the Massapequa Life Center location. They perform a variety of tasks, from preparing tagged
 bottles for our Baby Bottle Campaigns to helping with basic chores, such as light cleaning, vacuuming, and dusting. Their enthusiasm, selfless attitudes and smiling faces are an inspiration to us all. On June 17th, our Women First Pregnancy Options in Smithtown sponsored its first Sidewalk Advocacy for Life training.
