Theresa Bonapartis



heresa Bonopartis is the Director of Good Counsels Lumina Post Abortion Healing program. Theresa is the co-developer with The Sisters of Life of "Entering Canaan – a Sacramental Journey to an Inheritance of Mercy", a post-abortion ministry published by the U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops, which consists of day and weekend retreats, monthly gatherings, and special retreats. She also developed, with the Franciscan Friars of the Renewal, specialized days for men, siblings of aborted babies, and those who aborted due to an adverse diagnosis.

Having experienced abortion herself, her journey has inspired many works across the globe, including "An Afternoon of Prayerful Remembrance and Intercession", a prayer service she developed with the Family Life Office of NY, which has been televised by EWTN and conducted by many dioceses across the country. She has written articles for Mind

& Spirit, Aleteia, Catholic Online, Catholic Exchange, The Federalist, and National Catholic Register. Theresa also authored a book of meditations, "A Journey to Healing Through Divine Mercy", to assist in healing those suffering from abortion.

In 2002, Theresa received the 2nd Annual John Cardinal O'Connor Award for her work with those who are post-abortive. She currently serves on the Advisory Board of Be Not Afraid, a ministry for those who have received an adverse pregnancy diagnosis. Her great devotion to Divine Mercy, which was instrumental in her own healing journey, and Our Lady of Czestochowa, patroness of all her work, is the inspiration for all she does. FROM THE DESK OF The CEO Syncing Hope With Women HOPESYNC

With chemical abortions becoming more accessible and now accounting for over 60% of abortions, reaching an abortionvulnerable women is even more challenging. How do we reach her? *Through HopeSync!* HopeSync is a new pregnancy help communication tool and a vital resource when a young woman is undecided about her pregnancy.

Typically, after we meet with a client, our phone messages are not returned. This is where HopeSync comes in. Since this generation lives by electronics, HopeSync has developed a cutting-edge concept which communicates directly with women in crisis, including abortion-minded clients and those dealing with other "life" concerns. It will help us "reach clients.. in the moment...in their need... with consistency...and prayer."

We ran a test trial in February and March and immediately saw the potential life-changing impact this program would have on our clients. It will also benefit our donors and help promote continuing education for our staff and counselors. We were blessed through the generosity of a recent grant to sign up for a full-year subscription. Tons of useful content can now be delivered to our clients' devices with ease.

In seconds, we can send HopeSync's documented, physician-approved videos and literature that are relatable, compelling, and factual, directly to a client's device. We can share short videos from doctors, lawyers, counselors, and women who have been in the same situation. HopeSync validates and affirms for our clients what we have already shared with them in person. HopeSync also provides a Nurse Chat during the day in addition to our after-hours hotline "Optionline".

Through HopeSync, each concern is addressed in a three-fold manner: Educational, Professional and Relational. Educational: The educational literature aspect has all abortion facts, how it works, side effects and risks. Professional: Doctors who have performed abortions explain the detailed information on video. Relational: Testimonies from women who have experienced abortion are included.

HopeSync has over **205 literature titles, 174 videos, and 84 discussion points.** Information is consistently updated and will greatly benefit our staff and counselors. We can even add our own documents to HopeSync's literature library. While HopeSync communicates through electronic content, we'll still be able to share more traditional content during the counseling session.

Rather than handing a client a pile of brochures, HopeSync has allowed us to say, "We have talked about a few different things today. May I text you and follow up on what we've talked about with the chance to learn more?" Most of our clients have given us permission to send videos, literature, and information to their phones.

HopeSync does not replace but enhances an in-person client session! Clients still need and most request one-on-one interaction. Yet, for the woman that we talk with on the phone who won't or can't come into the center, this tool is priceless. Unlike before, we can now reach her virtually with testimonies of women who have been in her same situation. It opens the door for a follow-up session with that client.

HopeSync also addresses a variety of topics such as parenting, sexual health, and infant care.

Our donors can be involved in real time by signing up to be part of our "Prayer Train". Our advocates can text out prayer requests, such as: "Advocate Anne is meeting with a client who is considering abortion."

Administratively, HopeSync cuts down our tasks required for each intake. During a counseling session, we can now quickly and easily send information to our client's device and confirm they received it. We can provide a welcome text that recaps our services, answer some FAQs, and give the client our Facebook link. We're currently creating an exit survey to be texted to each client after their visit rather than filled out in our centers. Our resources, once on paper, can now be sent to our client's phones.

HopeSync is definitely a blessing to our ministry. We will keep you updated on HopeSync's impact with our clients!
