<u> Joy Beyond Christmas</u>

ur monthly newsletter often includes one of our consultant baby saves. The stories are always so encouraging and remind us how our mission truly saves lives, one baby and one family at a time. As one child of God effects so many other lives in that baby's circle of influence, we don't always here of what transpires way past the two-year mark of our baby saves. I would like to tell you of such a story.

Her name is Nancy*. She came to the center over 7 years ago for baby needs. At the time she was living in a shelter with her two children. She was on disability as she had been struck by a car.

Almost a year later she came back to us for a pregnancy test and some baby needs. She was abortion vulnerable. At this point her boyfriend was incarcerated. Nancy felt she had nowhere to turn, and abortion was her only option. Upon speaking with one of our counselors, the Life Center was able to share with her our position on helping her keep her baby! That was baby save number one. A new baby, a new sister, a new granddaughter! Her circle of influence grows before she is even born!


This is about where I came into the picture and started building a relationship with her over the next 5 years. We met regularly to talk about all kinds of relational issues. We spoke of her dreams, her fears, her tears, her financials and her future to grow and become sound in body, mind and soul.

Nancy returned two years later, this time in dire straits. She came in for baby needs. As she was ready to leave she asked for a pregnancy test kit. Of course, I asked her to return to the room so we could talk. Our relationship had grown to the point that I could be very frank with her and even instill some humor into this dire situation. Nancy shared with me that her test was positive. Of course, I said congratulations, but she did not appear too excited. As we started to share information, she became vulnerable and was able to tell me the truth. She did not know the father of her baby. It was one of two men that she had a relationship. We spoke of her options. At this point I understood that she was very much an abortion vulnerable client. We know from our work and training with Heartbeat International that once a mom considers abortion, she very rarely is free of an abortion decision. We scheduled Nancy for a sonogram so she could see her baby and bond with that baby immediately. She had the inkling that she could not go through with the abortion. Our relationship had grown into a trusting, genuine sisterhood. She knew what I shared with her was true and right. We would be there every step of the way. A new baby was born in the new year!

Nancy has grown tremendously over the years. She comes to the center more frequently and finally understands the benefit of utilizing local resources on her own for food, clothing, school supplies, and holiday support not only from us but from local churches and organizations. It takes guite a few conversations to help our clients understand the importance of reaching out on their own, become empowered, and have assistance for their families and

educating them on how to become empowered and make better choices for their families. When they are not working, I explain to them that this is their job to help their children and that one day they will be able to help others.

Love, Peace, and Joy

As we enter the Christmas season, the Life Center has much to be thankful for. As we rejoice in the birth of our savior Jesus Christ, we share the **love**, **peace**, **and joy** that night the Holy Family knew Jesus came to give us to share with the world. We are grateful to be God's instruments for the opportunity to provide that love, peace, joy, and hope to the women and men that seek our help and to whom we serve.

Our lives, country and world are far from perfect, with new challenges and struggles we all face. Even if there is much bad news and devastation in the world: the message of Christmas is timeless - the good news - doesn't change from year to year!

What a year we experienced at the Life Center! We faced increased attacks by the interception of our social media presence; abortion groups posting fake reviews about our work; threats and attacks on pregnancy care centers and prolife sidewalk advocates; multiple state legislative battles; and the expansion and accessibility of chemical abortions that now represent over **70%** of all abortions.

This new battleground in the fight for life presents new challenges around every corner and always on the horizon. Yet pregnancy help is, and will remain, more important than ever. To combat these challenges and better serve our clients, let me update you on three very successful resource initiatives we incorporated into the Life Center this year that saved lives:

Abortion Pill Reversal: Did you know that in the Bible the number 7 is mentioned 700 x and symbolizes completion or perfection? We received both! God completed our **seven-year search** and presented a breakthrough: a Nurse Practitioner here on LI, stepped out in faith and joined the APR network using her own liability insurance. With her, working with us, we have now **saved our 1st APR baby that was just born in July!** *We need more Doctors/Nurse Practitioners to join the APR Network because calls are increasing, and women want that second chance to save their babies lives!* Please forward those interested to contact me at 516-798-8746.

HopeSync: a cutting-edge concept, directly communicates via text with our abortion minded clients and those dealing with other "life" concerns. Our client website www.womenfirstpregnancyoptions.org has a chat feature during the day that lets our clients connect with us via text, in seconds and real-time, on our computers or by a secure text line to our cell phones. It allows us to communicate with a client (with her permission) before she even steps into our office, and for the woman that we talk with on the phone who won't/can't come into the center, this tool is priceless. We can send educational literature and 1-3 minute videos from former abortion Doctors. **Since inception in July, we have had over 200 client interactions!** HopeSync does not replace inperson client visits – it fills the gap between office visits and builds stronger relationships between the clients and our counselors.

SAFL (Sidewalk Advocates for Life): *Every sidewalk in front of an abortion clinic is a battle for life.* SAFL have a front-line peaceful presence at abortion clinics where vulnerable women and men are, connecting them, providing prayer, counsel, and practical resources to guide them to our pregnancy care centers, that will enable us to empower them to make a life decision. **Over 70% of women who see a Sidewalk Advocate will not keep their abortion appointment.** There is a tremendous need for more Sidewalk Advocates in order to have a stronger visible presence at abortion facilities all 365 days of the year. No matter the battle, we will not back down from offering hope to women at any point in her pregnancy. Our commitment is to her—to offer compassionate, caring, and truthful support.

At this Christmas season, we want you to know how much we appreciate you and how **your support helped us save lives!** The biggest battle we fight together is to defend the value of every life. **Every Gift you Give, Gives the Gift of Life!**
