



Two young ladies entered our Hempstead Center. Same day. Same time. In that particular moment, I was unaware of the profound impact each would have on the other. Theresa* entered our Center and like so many instances before, I observed the look of uncertainty on her face. Appearing hesitant and cautious, I greeted her warmly, hoping my kindness might put her fears and worry at ease. Incidentally, there was also another young client, Louise*, sitting in our reception area, waiting to be seen. Two very different individuals with two very different needs. Theresa was scheduled for a pregnancy test kit and was quite fearful of a positive result. Her intention, at that moment, was not to have a baby. As we had assured Louise, she was now coming to see us on a regular basis to supply her with whatever needs her baby may have at the time; diapers, wipes, clothing etc. There was a most notable difference between the two ladies. A few months prior, we offered Louise compassion, knowledge, education and material support. She now sat in a chair beaming with confidence and self-assurance knowing that choosing life for her baby was the best choice she ever made, rich in her understanding of the sanctity of Life. Quite the contrary for Theresa. She sat in her chair with an overwhelming sense of insecurity, self-doubt and fright. Louise recognized these feelings immediately with Theresa. In this very moment, things were about to change.

Louise broke the ice and extended a warm hello. It seemed as if the girls hit it off and began talking. Louise was upfront and honest about the many challenges but also spoke of the many blessings that God has bestowed on her with the gift of her newborn daughter. Sure, there would be difficulties, but the rewards would be so much greater.

We all prayed together, the girls exchanged phone numbers and then went along their way. A week went by and Theresa called to say she would keep her baby and shared how happy she was that she came to us and met Louise. We not only offered her assistance but most importantly, compassion. Additionally, Louise offered her truth and friendship.

Louise and Theresa have not only stayed in touch but have become close friends and get together on occasion. Both are doing quite well and are forever grateful that their paths crossed that day. Thanks be to God.

The promise and simplicity of the above verse reminds us that when we are filled with *His joy, we are strengthened* to continue to fight the battles before us in saving babies' lives. His strength is made perfect in our weakness.

On behalf of our Board of Directors, staff, and volunteers, we thank you, *our donors*, for a great 2023! Your prayers, life-giving financial support, and your inspiring calls and letters, have made the journey alongside all of you, even more meaningful and productive, as we serve the Lord together in this vital life-affirming work. Keeping Christ close to our hearts isn't always easy, but as we continue to journey through life, *carrying His lessons with us will open us up to infinite new possibilities*.

We have exciting goals for the Life Center in the New Year of 2024!

One of our new projects consists of much needed facelifts for our Hempstead and Massapequa centers such as new floors, lighting, painting, and updated chairs for our waiting and counsel rooms. This update will provide a much warmer welcome for our clients, and for them to know that we care enough about them with how we present ourselves to them. We invite you to become part of this exciting transition and would greatly appreciate any financial support and/or talents with accomplishing this project.

One of our new initiatives consists of reaching out to all the private and public schools here on Long Island, introducing and explaining the work of our pregnancy care centers - Women First Pregnancy Options — and invite them for a tour at any one of our centers. Our goal also, is to educate the students that although abortion is legal, coercion and undue pressure to a woman to abort is illegal. We will introduce and share the "Dear Parent letter, Father of the Baby letter, School Counselor letter, etc.," from the Justice Foundation as a resource for the students and schools. We are excited about this opportunity to reach our youth and welcome any suggested introductions to schools our donors may have.

We will also be expanding our Post Abortion Healing program that currently consists of *Surrendering the Secret* to include the well-known program *Lumina* that was founded by Theresa Bonapartis, who was our Guest Speaker this year at our Annual Gala. Please watch for upcoming information about the retreat date to share with someone, or someone they know, who might have interest in attending and long to be healed.

One of our ongoing operations for serving the Moms, Dads, and Grandparents in 2023 with material aid is on an upward trajectory for 2024. On average, we distribute the equivalent of over \$800,000 in material aid each year. Our **Adopt a Mom and Child Program** enables us to provide the much needed material aid support to the families we serve. It has changed the hearts of abortion vulnerable women who did not have the means to provide for their baby but now do. Please consider becoming a part of this program by participating and becoming a partner in our Adopt a Mom and Child program so we can have the resources available to serve the projected number of families in 2024 and save more babies lives.

Please stay tuned, be informed, and inquire how you can be a part of this journey together with us in saving more babies lives and expanding our support to build better communities here on Long Island!


