

HOPESYNC Award: Mary Bebber



hat is **HopeSync**? **HopeSync** is a new and enhanced educational program which increase our digital communication with women and men through program features to their mobile phones. **HopeSync** is a vital resource when a young woman is undecided about her pregnancy. It will help us "reach clients.. in the moment...in their need... with consistency...and prayer." In seconds, we can send **HopeSync's** documented, physician-approved videos and literature that are relatable, compelling, and factual, directly to a client's device. We can share short videos from doctors, lawyers, counselors, and women who have been in the same situation. Through **HopeSync**, each concern is addressed in a three-fold manner: Educational, Professional and Relational. Educational: The educational literature aspect has all abortion facts, how it works, side effects and risks. Professional: Doctors who have performed abortions explain the detailed information on video. Relational: Testimonies from women who have experienced abortion are included.


