

## From the Desk of the Director of Post Abortion and Pregnancy Loss Ministry

## The Gospel of Life SAINT JOHN PAUL II

"I would now like to say a special word to women who have had an abortion. The Church is aware of the many factors which may have influenced your decision, and she does not doubt that in many cases it was a painful and even shattering decision. The wound in your heart may not yet have healed. Certainly, what happened was and remains terribly wrong. But do not give in to discouragement and do not lose hope. Try rather to understand what happened and face it honestly. If you have not already done so, give yourselves over with humility and trust to repentance. The Father of mercies is ready to give you his forgiveness and peace in the Sacrament of Reconciliation. You will come to understand that nothing is definitively lost, and you will also be able to ask forgiveness from your child, who is now living in the Lord. With the friendly and expert help and advice of other people, and because of your own painful experience, you can be among the most eloquent defenders of everyone's right to life. Through your commitment to life, whether by accepting the birth of other children or by welcoming and caring for those most in need of someone to close to them, you will become promoters of a new way of looking at human life."

At the Life Center of Long Island, we believe we have been called to reach out to women, and men, who have experienced an abortion and lead them to healing. We have just completed another **Entering Canaan - A Woman's Retreat Day of Prayer & Healing**. One of the participants texted the following message to me:
