

Her baby was a blessing from God, and we were here to support her with any challenges she may face along the road ahead. We also took this opportunity to educate her on all the services WFPO can provide to her and her baby.... free of charge. We assured Amanda that she would not be alone on this journey, and WFPO would provide any and all the baby essentials that her little bundle would need; a car seat, bassinet, crib, diapers, wipes, clothing and so much more. Amanda went for her sonogram at The Gianna Center that we coordinated for her, but she was still unsure about keeping her baby. I tried to keep the lines of communication open but eventually she stopped all communication with us.





I thought of her often, wondering what her ultimate decision had been. Did we positively impact her in a way that she chose life for her baby? Or did she end her pregnancy? Fast forward to July 2025, out of the blue, I received a text with a beautiful picture of a newborn baby boy with the face of an angel. I was overcome with joy when I realized I was looking at a picture of Amanda's newborn little boy. Her message brought tears to my eyes. She stated that coming to WFPO that day saved her life and gave her the best blessing that she could ever imagine. She said that she often thought of us and our encouraging words and that we were her Angels. Her parents could not be happier and are thrilled to be grandparents. The best news of all, Amanda's decision to accept this precious gift from God has completely transformed Amanda (and her extended family's) future into a bright optimistic journey as opposed to a dark and undesirable path that Amanda had envisioned for herself. Amanda and her boyfriend have decided they want to raise their son together as a family. They are happily engaged and look forward to watching their beautiful son thrive and grow.

The following is a brief overview of my remarks that were shared at our most recent Gala event.



Baby Save

Dear Friends,

Welcome to our 39th Anniversary at the Life Center! This past fiscal year 45 babies' lives have been saved; we served over 3,100 client visits; and distributed the equivalent value of over \$1.2 million of much needed baby material aid to over 2,900 Moms and Dads. In our 39 years, we served over 76,000 client visits and saved over 2,400 babies that we actually know of.

Matthew 7:7 reads, "Ask, and it will be given to you; seek, and you will find; knock, and the door will be opened to you". We set exciting and ambitious goals for this year with numerous items on our "bucket list." Little did I know that God planned to open the doors to these goals simultaneously! When God opens a door, you got to walk through it. You answer His call when He decides to present it! We knew we would do our best to accomplish the goals, not just try. Excellence is not having the best of everything; Excellence is doing the best with everything you have. Yet God provided what we needed in the journey to achieve His plans.

What we have accomplished:

- * Implemented the Entering Canaan Post Abortion Healing Ministry which includes Day and Weekend Retreats for Women and for Men. In addition, the Life Center initiated a Pregnancy Loss Ministry for pregnancy loss due to miscarriage, ectopic, and stillbirth.
- * **HopeSync client digital program** increases client interaction via digital communication from the HopeSync website through our computers to our clients' phones.
- * Initiating BrightCourse Educates clients through numerous online or in-person workshops
- * Training enriched our top-notch training development initiatives for staff and volunteers
- * **Donor website** upgrading site with enhanced features
- * Marketing/social media increased presence through Google Ads, Reels, FB/Instagram
- * **Hempstead and Massapequa centers updated** with new lighting, floors, and painting to ensure our clients know we care enough about them with how we present our centers to them.
- * **School presence** approaching schools to educate students and school staff about the work of our pregnancy care centers and invite them to tour at any one of our centers.

On behalf of our Board of Directors, staff, and volunteers, we thank you, our donors, for a very productive and successful 2025 so far! Your prayers, life-giving financial support, and your inspiring calls and letters, have made the journey alongside all of you, even more meaningful and productive, as we serve the Lord together in this vital life- affirming work. As we journey together, God's grace, opens us up to infinite new possibilities.
