

MIRACULOUS TWIST



Working in the pro-life movement, one never knows what the day may bring. We must always be alert and seek God's will in our every thought, word and deed. For we never know how our very actions through God's Grace may change the course of someone's very life. This was the case on October 16th.

Since joining the Life Center of Long Island, my work life has had a very structured yet rewarding quality. I have learned over the few years that we must always put God first in our day and seek His will in all things. This day started like every other day for me with daily Mass at St Patrick's RC Church. After Mass, I pray the Rosary in front of Planned Parenthood before heading to the office. I have built wonderful relationships with the other men and women who come out to offer that last ray of hope for the women dealing with an unexpected pregnancy. This was very true for this particular Friday when the surgical abortions are performed.

I received a call from Joe, one of the male sidewalk counselors. He was praying outside of Planned Parenthood. He had an urgent request. Joe was sending down a young mom, Karen, who had her 4-month old daughter with her. This wasn't the urgency though. You see, Karen did not go to PP to have an abortion herself. No, she had dropped off her friend, Carol. With the knowledge upfront from Joe, I was able to meet with Karen. While talking with her, I got to know a lot about Karen. We try to build a relationship of trust. Doing so, I was able to learn about Karen's past. She had admitted that she had 2 abortions. These grieved her so much so that she chose life with her last pregnancy. She had admitted that she was not healed from the hurt nor the regret that she felt. Karen was open to learn about our post-abortion healing and the Graces that God has for her when you seek repentance.

Having walked Karen through the steps with our Love Approach process, I was then able to turn my attention to her friend Carol who had entered PP. I asked Karen if she thought it would be better for her to reach out to Carol and ask her to leave PP. If her friend choose life, she could avoid all of the pain and suffering she had endured. However, Karen was adamant that Carol felt that she had no other option. Despite saying this to me, Karen was definitely texting someone during our conversation. Could it have been Carol? I do not know. I had hoped so, but Karen never told me. When we concluded our session, I made another request to Karen to reach out to Carol. I wasn't sure if she would.

About 30 minutes after Karen left, I received another call from Joe. This time you could hear the joy in his voice. You see, Karen came out of PP with Carol in tow. They shouted out of the window that Carol had chosen to keep her baby!!!! Joe had told them to come back to me so that I could help Carol too. However, I never saw them again. Which is all good as God is the victor and not me.

But, the story doesn't end there. A week later, I reached out to Karen to see how she was doing. My intention was dual fold. Karen didn't know that I knew that Carol had changed her mind. However, Karen couldn't wait to tell me the great news. Carol found out that she was carrying TWINS! I cannot help but think that God saved not one life but 4 that day. Carol, her twins and Karen who now knows that all things are possible with God. His Mercy and Love endures forever.

Traditionally, a 40th anniversary is symbolized by the gemstone Ruby that represents enduring love, passion, strength, and the fiery devotional commitment of four decades.

The gemstone properties of ruby remind me of the significance and similarities of the ruby red slippers made famous by the character Dorothy Gale (Judy Garland) in the movie, The Wizard of Oz and that of the Life Center. You may remember the iconic scene in the movie when Dorothy clicks her heels together and chants, *“There’s no place like home.”* Her journey represents good overcoming evil through **Hope & Protection**, the magical protection from the Wicked Witch that evil can be overcome with inner strength; **Revolution & Liberation**, taking evil by seizing power, symbolizing revolution against oppression; and **Transformation**, transform a situation by reflecting and finding oneself and personal growth. These are attributes we educate, equip and empower our clients at the Life Center with the women and men we serve.

As we embark on our 40th anniversary, we celebrate our journey throughout the years by serving over 77,000 client visits, saving over **2,600 babies lives**, and distributing an annual average equivalent of over \$1,000,000 of material aid to our clients. Our committed goal for this New Year and the next 40 years is to remain steadfast enhancing our operations to exceed client expectations and reflect that ***there is no place like the Life Center!***

Although evil surrounds us, there is a strong sense of revival in the air.

- More than 40 Planned Parenthood locations have closed this year, including the Margaret Sanger in NYC.
- Planned Parenthood has lost its federal funding for a year.
- After years of declining marriage rates, more people are beginning to embrace marriage, according to The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) reports.
- Divorce rates are at their lowest in decades.
- More people, especially men, are returning to Church and their faith.

These subtle changes point to what is coming: a potential and desperately needed **baby boom!**

The New Year brings fresh starts, resolutions and new beginnings. It is a time for writing visions, setting goals, and making plans. - * **Men’s Post Abortion Healing Program** – Under Deacon Fred’s leadership, our men’s program is continuing to grow.

It is my sincerest hope that you will partner again with us in our critical effort to reach young mothers and fathers, rescue the unborn, and renew hope in the lives of millions.

Bottom line: **YOU CAN MAKE THE DIFFERENCE** between a mother choosing life or death for her unborn child.




MARIA REGINA ROSARY SOCIETY


